A REGULAR MEETING of the BOARD OF ALDERMEN of the TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS, was held on SEPTEMBER 10, 2024, at 6:00 P.M., in the TOWN MUNICIPAL OFFICE, 3301 CARMEN AVENUE, RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS to consider the following items:

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Guerrero at 6:00 PM.

Mayor Guerrero was present via Teams Meetings.

2. ROLL CALL:

Roll call was made by Isabel Perales, Executive Administrative Assistant.

Members present at the meeting were: Alderwoman Christi Burnias, Alderman Todd Day, Alderman Mark Johnson *via Teams Meetings*, Alderman Marcos Ricoy, Alderman Javier Vera.

A quorum was present at the meeting.

Legal counsel David Irwin and Daniel Rentfro, Jr., Town Administrator Fred Blanco, and Police Chief Robert R. Tyler were also present at the meeting.

3. INVOCATION AND PLEDGE:

Alderman Vera led the group in the invocation and the pledge of allegiance to the American and Texas Flags.

4. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mayor Guerrero opened public comment. There were no comments from the audience.

5. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – REGULAR MEETING AUGUST 13, 2024, SPECIAL MEETING AUGUST 26, 2024, SPECIAL MEETING SEPTEMBER 3, 2024:

Motion was made by Alderman Vera, seconded by Alderman Ricoy, and unanimously carried, to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on August 13, 2024, as written.

Motion was made by Alderman Johnson, and seconded by Alderwoman Burnias, to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting held on August 26, 2024, as written. Motion passed with the following vote:

AYES: Alderwoman Burnias, Alderman Johnson, Alderman Ricoy.

Motion was made by Alderman Vera, seconded by Alderman Ricoy, and unanimously carried, to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting held on September 3, 2024, as written.

6. CONSIDERATION/ADOPTION OF BUDGET ORDINANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2024, TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2025:

Motion was made by Alderman Day, seconded by Alderwoman Burnias, and unanimously carried, to approve Ordinance No. 257 – AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN, APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS, AS PREPARED BY THE MAYOR FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024 - 2025.

Motion passed with the following vote:

7. CONSIDERATION/RATIFICATION OF THE PROPERTY TAX (REVENUE) INCREASE REFLECTED IN THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2024, TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2025:

Motion was made by Alderman Vera, seconded by Alderwoman Burnias, and unanimously carried, to adopt a tax rate of 0.450000, which is effectively a 6.0835% increase in the no new revenue tax rate.

Motion passed with the following vote:

8. CONSIDERATION/ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH AD VALOREM TAX RATE TO PROVIDE FOR BUDGET EXPENSES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 – 2025:

Motion was made by Alderman Ricoy, seconded by Alderwoman Burnias, and unanimously carried, to approve Ordinance No. 258 - AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE AD VALOREM AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX RATE FOR THE TAX YEAR 2025, SETTING THE ASSESSED VALUATION AT ONE HUNDRED PERCENT (100%) OF THE FAIR MARKET VALUE, PROVIDING FOR A HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION OF \$5,000, PROVIDING FOR DISCOUNTS IN THE EVENT OF EARLY PAYMENT, AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTY AND INTEREST IN ACCORDANCE WITH STATE LAW AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

Motion passed with the following vote:

AYES: Alderwoman Burnias, Alderman Day, Alderman Johnson, Alderman Ricoy, and Alderman Vera.

9. AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) MULTI-USE FACILITY PROJECT UPDATE – RUDY GOMEZ, GMS ARCHITECTS, AND JASON MARTINEZ, GRANTWORKS:

Rudy Gomez with GMS Architects recommended that the Town work together with Cameron County

to align their projects during the same period to save some money on mobilization costs.

Jason Martinez with GrantWorks added that the Town may request a formal solicitation, but he reinstated what Mr. Gomez recommended, to work with the County to save some costs on the equipment to be used for the installation of the roof structure.

10. CONSIDERATION/ACTION ON CONTRACT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF CAMERON COUNTY, TEXAS, AND THE TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO, TEXAS, ON ARPA FUNDS GRANT TO BE USED FOR THE MULTI-USE FACILITY PROJECT:

Motion was made by Alderman Day, seconded by Alderman Vera, and unanimously carried, to approve a Contract Agreement between the County of Cameron County, Texas, and the Town of Rancho Viejo, Texas, on ARPA Funds Grant to be used for the Multi-Use Facility Project, Contract# 2024C09341.

11. CONSIDERATION/ACTION ON AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN REGION 8 EDUCATION SERVICE CENTER AND THE TOWN OF RANCHO VIEJO TO PROVIDE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING SERVICES THROUGH A PROGRAM KNOWN AS THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM PROGRAM(TIPS):

Motion was made by Alderwoman Burnias, seconded by Alderman Day, and unanimously carried, to approve an Interlocal Agreement between Region 8 Education Service Center and the Town of Rancho Viejo to provide Cooperative Purchasing Services through a program known as The Interlocal Purchasing System Program (TIPS).

12. CONSIDERATION/ACTION ON A RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM (TIPS) PROGRAM:

Motion was made by Alderman Johnson, seconded by Alderman Day, and unanimously carried, to approve Resolution No. 401 - A RESOLUTION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INTERLOCAL PURCHASING SYSTEM PROGRAM (TIPS).

13. CONSIDERATION/ACTION TO APPROVE THE ARPA MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) OBLIGATING \$586,681.11 IN AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) FUNDS FOR THE MULTI-USE FACILITY PROJECT:

Jason Martinez with GrantWorks stated that there had been some communication with the Town's legal counsel and that they made minor modifications to the MOU. Legal Counsel Daniel Rentfro, Jr. confirmed that Mr. Martinez also provided clarification on the Department of Treasury guidelines. Mr. Martinez then stated that they would have to add a contract number to the MOU.

Motion was made by Alderman Day, seconded by Alderman Ricoy, and unanimously carried, to approve the ARPA Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) obligating \$586,681.11 in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds for the Multi-Use Facility Project and to add a contract number to the MOU as per guidelines, Contract #2302.

14. CONSIDERATION/ACTION OF APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS TO THE BEAUTIFICATION/STRATEGIC PLANNING COMMITTEE:

Mayor Guerrero recommended the appointment of Tita Teran as a member to the Beautification Committee.

Motion was made by Alderman Day, seconded by Alderman Ricoy, and unanimously carried, to appoint Tita Teran as a member to the Beautification Committee.

15. CONSIDERATION/ACTION TO CAST OFFICIAL BALLOT FOR THE TEXAS MUNICIPAL LEAGUE (TML) REGION 12 DIRECTOR:

Mayor Guerrero recommended the nomination of Bryan L. Martinez to the Board of Trustees – TML Region 12 Director. Motion was made by Alderwoman Burnias, and seconded by Alderman Ricoy to nominate Bryan L. Martinez for the Board of Trustees – TML Region 12 Director.

Motion passed with the following vote:

The board is to solicit for applications for Town Administrator. The 2025 budget rate of 3% COLA increase still applies and he may reapply for the position. Either party can terminate with a 30-day written notice.
